A PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE THE PAULINE PRIVILEGE

Introduction:

"A marriage entered into by two non-baptized persons is dissolved by means of the Pauline Privilege in favor of the faith of the party who has received baptism by the very fact that a new marriage is contracted by the same party, provided that the non-baptized party departs." C. 1143, §1.

What must be proven:

- 1. The Petitioner has never been baptized or has only been baptized since the parties to the prior marriage stopped living together.
- 2. The Respondent has never been baptized in any form recognized by the Catholic Church, up to the present time.
- 3. The Respondent does not wish to receive baptism.
- 4. The Petitioner was not the direct cause of the failure of the prior marriage.
